WELCOME!



During the rehearsals for what is to be our 28th show, I asked some of the cast and crew why they do the show. The most common replies were, 'friendships, fun, learning, confidence and the experience of being on stage'. As some of you may know, Scouting and Guiding have a set of key principles. Whilst Scouting talks about 'Skills for life', Guiding refers to 'We Discover, We Grow'. So, I'm immensely proud to be at the helm of a show that offers skills for life, whilst the Gang discover new friendships and grow in confidence and competence.

For those who are, or know people involved in Gang Shows, you know what an impact it has. For those who don't, the show doesn't just happen by accident! It's an accumulation of thousands of volunteer hours for the committee, staff, crew and band and months of rehearsing for the cast. And remember, of course, that many of the cast aren't members of any dance or drama group, so this is their chance to shine and perform for an audience in a show that is steeped in history.

The first London Gang Show in 1932, produced by Ralph Reader, was such a success he was asked to repeat the experience. There are now over 115 shows in the UK and many more around the globe.

Our show, 'It's a Date', was first performed here at the Palace Theatre in 1966. Since then the Gang have performed at the Cliffs Pavillion, the O2 and The Royal Albert Hall. Whilst some shows elsewhere take place annually, we run a two-year cycle and in the 'odd year' we produce a show in a day (SHINDIGS), where the cast

arrive at 10am and perform at 7pm. An exhausting yet exhilarating experience. Then in the 'even year' we put on the main show, making sure we have a calendar of events to keep all involved.

This year has been full of highs and lows. We ran a very successful fund-raising barn dance with the Famous Potatoes, won Best Participants in the Leigh Lights Parade and the trophy for Best Youth Choir at the Southend Musical Festival. We also sadly lost four close friends of the Show this year. Lesley Jenkins, my joint Show Manager, Mark Brudenell, the Treasurer on our committee, Derek Evans, who directed my first show in the 1980s and John Puddick, our previous Musical Director who has written and arranged many songs for the Show including some from this one. So, if you hear us singing crest of a wave with a little more emotion than usual, we will be doing so whilst thinking of them all.

I mentioned at the beginning that I'm proud to belong to the Gang and I hope you enjoy the show as much as the cast and crew enjoy being part of it. So now there is nothing more to say other than sit back, relax, cheer, clap, shout, whoop and, of course, enjoy the show.
